- Military Duty Tour, Active Guard/Reserve (AGR), under Title 32, U.S.C., Sec 502(f) Three (3) years with the potential for follow on tours.
- IAW ANGI 36-101, follow on tours for members with at least 20 years of TAFMS will be approved in 1-2 year increments.
- Open to **Females**.
- Open to current enlisted members of 181st IW/ASOS whom have been selected by the board to become Commissioned Officers in the Indiana Air National Guard.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Serves as an Air Liaison Officer (ALO) and Joint Terminal Attack Controller (JTAC) ultimately obtaining instructor and evaluator status. Oversees unit training encompassing the full cycle of theory, formal classroom, and actual field performance for Tactical Air Control Parties (TACP) activities. Instructs unit personnel on ALO, TAC, and TACP knowledge, skills, and abilities. In exercise, training, and evaluation environments, instructs on the Theater Air Ground System and the application of Air and Space power to support the ground commander's Concept of Operations (CONOPs). Serves as a senior squadron planner. Duties include long range planning, scheduling and training for current and future operations based on unit mission and tasking. Participates in planning worldwide exercises and deployments. Acts as the unit subject matter expert on integration and coordination of Air and Space power across the spectrum of command, from the ground maneuver unit to the theater level, providing input and advice to the commander. Incumbent performs duties necessary to ensure unit personnel are properly trained and certified to support recurring TACP operations training and readiness.

GENERAL EXPERIENCE

Experience with technical and analytical work pertaining to the planning, development, acquisition, testing, integrations, installation, utilization, or modification of telecommunications systems, facilities, services, and procedures. Managerial and staff work in planning, implementation, or program management or

telecommunications programs, systems and services. Direct supervision over communications operations, when such work includes responsibility for management functions such as planning, recommending changes and determining organizational structure, staffing, training, and budgetary requirements. Experience, education, or training involving the knowledge of the needs of communications users. Experience using computer and automation systems.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS/CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

- If a Maj/O4 is selected to fill this vacancy they cannot be appointed until a control grade is available.
- Once selected and assigned, AGR members must remain in the position for a minimum of twenty-four (24) months.
- Applicants must meet requirements of ANGI 10-248, Air National Guard (ANG) Fitness Program.
- Applicants must have sufficient time remaining on current ANG enlistment or mandatory removal date to complete AGR Tour.
- Applicants should be able to complete 20 years Total Active Federal Military Service prior to reaching mandatory separation date (age 60).
- Once selected, members must maintain qualifications for mobilization and attend all Unit Training Assemblies (UTA), exercises, and periods of annual training.
- Security Clearance:** Applicants must be eligible to obtain a **TOP SECRET** security clearance.
- Medical/Physical:** Applicants must meet any medical standards or physical requirements designated for the position.
- Direct Deposit/Electronic Fund Transfer Program:** Selected candidate is required to participate as a condition of employment.
